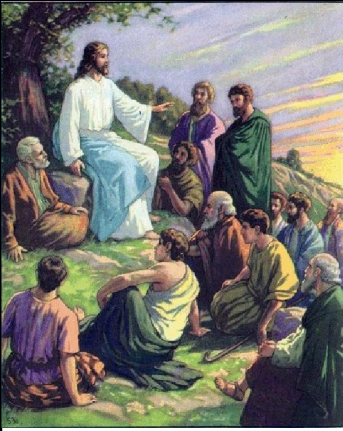

DYING TO LIVE

THE POWER OF FORGIVENESS

Continued

We continue our examination of Dr. Senkbeil's "DYING TO LIVE: The Power of Forgiveness".

Consider Psalm 19:14: "Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in your sight, O LORD, my rock and my redeemer." (ESV)

"Mouth" and "Heart". With our "hearts" we believe, that is, all of our trust is in His promises, and particularly His promise that we have forgiveness, reconciliation, and eternal life for the sake of His Son, and with our "mouths" we confess that faith. "For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved." (Romans 10:10; ESV) "We confess", "literally 'say together'". (Senkbeil, p. 154) Believing, i.e. having saving faith, and speaking that faith "go together". (id)

There are certainly times where "the mouth falters, but the heart carries on. Thankfully, God, who sees and hears in secret, understands the language of the heart....Still, we would do well to keep our mouths linked with our hearts when we pray; private prayer works best when it is oral prayer." (id) When we, praying privately, pray out loud, and particularly when we pray the Psalms or other passages of the Holy Scriptures out loud, "that Word strikes the eardrums as well as the heart." (Senkbeil, p. 155) Even in our private prayer, it is His Word that comes first, then we respond to His Word. "Our liturgical life together and our liturgical life alone invite us into the presence of the same Holy Trinity. In His presence there is always one assembly, seen and unseen: the fellowship of angels, archangels, and the church in earth and heaven." (id)

It is Satan who tempts us to avoid frequent and regular participation in the visible assembly of believers while deceiving ourselves that we can be people of prayer all alone. The Divine Services at Zion and the Bible studies offered at Zion are Jesus Christ's invitation to you to be fed by and to grow in His saving Word. Join us!

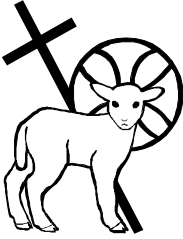
