Zion Lutheran School & Early Childhood Center operates with its own School Board and is licensed with the State of Texas to care for children from infancy through twelve years.

Our Mission...

The school, Childhood Center, and Church work together to ensure that every child at our facility is cared for in a Christ-like manner, that all individuals are shown the highest degree of respect, and treated as fellow creatures for whom Christ has died.

Curriculum for the soul...

To fulfill our mission, we use the Concordia Publishing Growing in Christ Series, which is adaptable for all ages. It uses appropriate traditional pictures, flannel graphs & classroom activities to reinforce the stories. The Concordia Publishing Growing in Christ Series enables the teacher to integrate the Lutheran Faith into every aspect of the daily lesson plans.

Our older children attend chapel every Thursday morning at 9:00 a.m.. The service is conducted by one of our Pastors, and parents are invited to attend with their child. On special occasions, the children sing in the Sunday morning church service.

Curriculum for the body & mind...

The goal of our program is to guide children toward their highest potential through meaningful learning experiences.

In order to accomplish this, we use a secular curriculum, written by Early Childhood Experts and published by Pinnacle, and is NAEYC* approved. This program is designed to engage children in developmentally appropriate learning through hands-on and child-directed activities, focusing on emerging skills beginning at the infant level. Through these activities, our teachers help children develop a love for learning while growing, playing, and having fun.
